As indicated the rally will take the form of an Otago Southland Tour. A full programme of activities is planned during the Rally. These will include, subject to final arrangements, such activities as:

7th February - Welcome, Registrations and Rally Briefing at the Conference room, Victoria Hotel and Welcome Dinner at 7pm at Edgar Centre, Portsmouth Drive, Dunedin – Buses provided to and from the venue – Buses pickup at Victoria at 6.30pm and return at 9pm, 9.30pm and 10pm

8th February - Concours d'état and Public Display of cars – To be held in the Octagon, Central Dunedin – 8am until 12.30pm then Lunch Otago Peninsula Trial – Part of the competitive section of the rally - 1.30pm – Free Evening

9th February - *Touring Day 1* – Day Tour from Dunedin (leaving after breakfast) to Ascot Park Hotel, Invercargill via the Southern Scenic Route through The Catlins and Eastern South Coast. - *Free Evening*
